"Sticks and Stones"

An Original Pattern by Diane Rogness

Taught by Diane Rogness

Here is an easy quilt top to make using "sticks" (a jelly roll or 40 2 1/2 inch strips) and "stones" (a layer cake or 32 10 inch squares). The quilt will finish approximately 72 inches square without borders. It is a good quilt for beginners as the blocks are trimmed before sewing together and whatever size they are, they are. The blocks can be laid out any way you wish similar to the way you would arrange log cabin blocks. This is also a great quilt for those who need to put a quick quilt together or make a couple of quick baby quilts.

"Wool Applique—With Del Rae"

Taught by Del Rae Martin

I am going to be teaching various ways to do wool applique. I will not have a specific pattern to use for this class. Rather, I would like you to purchase a kit from a reputable quilt shop that appeals to you. I would ask if they have a thread kit that you can purchase to match your kit. If not, after you get your kit I would recommend the Valdani web site or Primitive Gatherings/Buttermilk Basin for pearl cottons to use with your wool kit. My goal for this class is to get you comfortable with different ways to secure wool to the background and exploring different stitches to use to applique and embellish your quilt.

Supply list for "Wool Applique with Del Rae" class

Items useful for appliqueing with wool:

#8 and/or #12 perle cotton [I prefer the Valdani brand, but I also use DMC. I know there are newer brands that have just come available but I have not used them yet.] Presencia, Anchor

Embroidery floss

Embroidery needles [Kim Diehl prefers size 5, Lisa Bongean prefers chenille needle size 24] I prefer an embroidery needle size 8 and have also used a size 7.

Paper-backed iron-on adhesive [Kim prefers Heat n Bond Lite, Lisa prefers SteamASeam 2 and I prefer SteamASeam 2 Lite, there is also a new Heat n Bond Featherweight available that Sharon Sorenson has used but I have not tried yet.]

Freezer paper-if not using a fusible product.

Stapler

If you have needle felting supplies bring them as option

Liquid fabric-basting glue, water soluble and acid free if not using a fusible product. [Kim prefers Quilter's Choice Basting Glue by Beacon Adhesives]

Light Box-will have 2-3 available but if yours is portable please bring.

Sharp scissors with fine point

Thimble

Pellon fusible medium weight interfacing if using wool as a background fabric

19th Annual 'Frozen Fabric Frolic' Quilt Retreat

Missouri Valley Quilters, Bismarck-Mandan Will be held at Camp of the Cross, Garrison ND February 15-17, 2019

Quilt Retreat will begin at 5:00 PM Friday evening and will end 4:00 PM Sunday evening

\$150 Registration Fee will cover room, board and classes. (\$75 required with application.)

Meals are provided. (Supper Friday evening. Brunch & Supper Saturday. Brunch Sunday)

(Cancellations before Feb. 11, 2019 will receive a refund minus a \$10 non-refundable registration fee.)

Accommodations are dormitory style cabins - (no bunk beds).

Bring your own sleeping bag, pillow, towels, etc.

Each cabin has its own bathrooms, but shower facilities are located in another building.

A limited number of "Private Rooms" are available for an additional \$35/person. Some of the rooms will accommodate two people, (2 single beds.) Bedding & towels are provided by the camp. These rooms will be filled on a "First come-first served" basis. We cannot guarantee you a private room.

You will have your choice of two classes, or space will be provided to do your own projects.

(Each class will be for two days, giving time to perhaps complete a project)
Class size is limited to 16 and will be filled as registrations are received.

Applications will be accepted based on postmark, but will not be accepted early.

Open registration will begin January 1, 2019 for non-member of MVQ.
