Barb H. supply list for a Potholder Class:

Supplies for one potholder:

Six - 9" or 10" squares of fabric--2 each of three coordinating fabrics,

One - 9" or 10" square insulated batting; "Insul-Bright" or something comparable,

One - 9" or 10" square of *Cotton* batting (polyester will NOT insulate well), 2 ½ x 5" fabric scrap or ribbon if you desire a hanging tab. Of course, double these supplies to make a pair!

The supply list for Del Rae's Potholder Class:

Six- 9-inch squares and One- 9-inch square of thinsulate batting. To make a pair they would need 12 squares.

What You Need to Bring To Make Pot Holders

The guild will supply the thin-sulate batting for 2 pot holders per member.

Barb H. supply list for a Potholder Class:

Supplies for one potholder:

Six 9" or 10" squares of fabric--2 each of three coordinating fabrics **One** 9" or 10" square insulated batting—"Insul-Bright" or something comparable

One 9" or 10" square of *Cotton* batting (polyester will NOT insulate well)
2 ½ x 5" fabric scrap or ribbon if you desire a hanging tab

Of course, double these supplies to make a pair!
