

Make & Take— Pin Wheels Material List

* Please bring the following items list for the June Meeting:

4-10" layer cake squares –high contrast colors

4-5" Charm Squares—high contrast color

2-10" Square heat & Bond Ultra or Decca Bond

2-5" Square of Heat & Bond Ultra or Decca Bond

Pinking Shears or scissors, small iron and ironing mat

3-5 decorative stick pins or buttons

Depending on the size you use; either the 5" squares or the 10 " squares, depends on the size of your pin wheel you make.
