Pillowcase Project

Missouri Valley Quilters (along with other quilters in the area such as Capital Quilters) have partnered with and Sewing Machines Plus and Bismarck Sewing and Quilting to participate in the Million Pillowcase Challenge proposed by American Patchwork & Quilting magazine. The February 2016 count is now at **660,731**. This challenge will run until the million is reached!

Sewing Machines Plus of Mandan and Bismarck Sewing and Quilting, of Bismarck have consented to be drop off points for pillowcases. Capital Quilters provides help with the distribution. The following is a list of the locations that receive pillowcases from this joint effort: Amber's Dream, Welcome House, PATH, Children's Advocacy Center, Carrie's Kids, Ruth Meiers House, St. Alexis Pediatrics, Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch, Ronald McDonald, Charles Hall, Tracey's Sanctuary, Community Action, Manchester House/Hope Home, AID incorporated, BECEP and Salvation Army.
