Next meeting will be held on Thursday, May 18th at House of Prayer Lutheran Church. Upcoming meetings will include: June information on pins and needles, hand quilting, embellishments. Reminder of the August challenge

Treasurer's Report - Current Balance - \$4,299.88 (includes Warm Start balance - \$427.85)

National Teacher – Income from National Teacher - \$3,413.00; Expenses - \$2,675.31; Balance - \$737.69. Cathy Wierzbicki's fees were approximately \$200 less per workshop than previous teachers; did not need to pay air fare - contributed to the \$737.69 balance. Michelle Ripplinger will submit a report.

Discussed having a "Stay Vacation" rather than a national teacher. The "Stay Vacation" would be in Bismarck, rent a large room at a hotel for a weekend where the sewing machines could be left overnight and quilters could bring their projects and sew all weekend. Like the Frozen Frolic but in Bismarck where quilters could go home every night. This event could be held every year rather than every other year (i.e. National Teacher.) If the Guild members are interested in this a committee should be formed.

If Guild members would like to sponsor a national teacher in 2018 – consider moving the date of the event to the fall. A committee should be formed also if this option is chosen.

Christmas Party – Committee includes Diana T, Barb Emery, Melinda, Barb Wrolstad and Denise Rossert. .




