Freindship1/2 Square Triangle Exchange

Information:

- Quilters should use quality fabric
- 2” finished 1.2 square triangle paper
- Do not remove the paper or open the triangles when finished
- Write your name and the number of 1/2 squares triangles enchanted on your container or envelope
- You get back the same number of triangle squares you trade
