- Quilt Retreat begins at 3:00 PM Friday and ends at 4:00 PM Sunday.
- \$170 Registration Fee covers lodging in the retreat Cabins and meals: Supper Friday, Brunch & Supper Saturday, Brunch Sunday.
- Cabins are dormitory style. Each cabin has its own bathrooms, but shower facilities are located in another building. You will need to bring your own bedding, pillows, towels, etc.
- Limited number of private rooms in the retreat Lodge are available for an additional \$35/person. Showers are available in the Lodge and bedding & towels are provided by the camp. The private rooms will be filled as "First come-first served" based on your application postmark.
- Members of Missouri Valley Quilters may send in their registration on December 1, 2019
- Open registration will begin January 1, 2020 for non-members of MVQ.
- Applications will be accepted based on postmark, but will not be accepted early.
- \$70 is required with application. Cancellation before Feb. 15, 2020 will receive a refund minus \$10
